Zarda (Sweet rice)

Zarda is made for special occasions, and is surprisingly yummy! Enough for 6 portions

2 cups of rice, 1/2 tbsp raisins (Kishmish), 1/2 tbsp. walnuts,(Akhrot) (chopped), 1/2 tbsp. almonds (Baadaam) (chopped) ,1 tsp. grated orange zest, 6 small cardamom pods (Choti Ilaichi), 2 tbsp. double cream, 2 cups sugar, 1 tbsp. vegetable oil

- 1) Soak rice in water for 10 to 15 minutes.
- 2) In a large pot combine: water & 3 cardamom pods; bring to a boil. Slowly stir in rice, reduce heat, cover and simmer until rice is tender, (about 20 minutes)
- 3) In a large skillet over low heat, fry the remaining 3 cardamom pods in oil for about 2 minutes
- 4) Stir in the cooked, drained rice, and sugar. Cover and cook for another 5 minutes.
- 5) Remove from heat and stir in the cream, raisins, walnuts, almonds and orange zest

Tomorrow is Mothering Sunday—Many mothers worry about the future of their children, like Aishal. She worries that she wont be able to provide good education for her daughter, or shield her from the harsh realities of poverty in Pakistan.

Pray for the women in your family, about their hopes, dreams and struggles.



Tues 10th

Thank you God for spare time. I have time to fill with relaxation, sports, hobbies and friends. I pray for those who don't have the luxury of spare time, may you fill their lives with your peace. Amen

Thursday 12th

Lord, we thank you that we have access to lots of books. We can buy, take-out, borrow, lend and swap. We know our favourites, and that's not a result of a lack of choice. Help us to be thankful for the books in our libraries, schools and personal collections. Help us to use and share our resources wisely. We pray for all those who do not have the opportunity to 'enjoy a good book'. Amen

Chana (Chickpea) Curry - Serves 8 — freezable

800g tinned chickpeas, 2 chopped onions, (You can use 3 tsp medium curry powder instead of individual spices, but whole spices taste so much better!) 1/4 inch piece of ginger chopped, 2 cloves of garlic chopped, 1 tin chopped tomatoes, 1 tbs cooking oil, 1 tsp cumin, 1/2 tsp turmeric, 1 tsp coriander, 1/2 tsp garam masala, 1 chilli, fresh coriander leaves (If you can get hold of fresh coriander, it is definitely worth it!)

- 1) Rinse chickpeas and set aside. Crush some of the chickpeas to make the sauce nice and thick.
- 2) Heat the oil in a medium sized pan, add whole spices (if using) and wait until they begin to spit.
- 3) Add onions, garlic, ginger & powdered spices. Fry until golden. Add tomatoes and chickpeas and 1 cup water.
- 4) Add salt & chilli to your own taste.
- 5) Cook covered for 20 mins.
- 6) Add fresh coriander to garnish.
- 7) Serve with Chappati and rice

Thank you Jesus that I am able to choose what I do to earn money. Even if I only have a small choice, I do have one. I pray for those who have no choice, especially for those who work in Baddomalhi's brick factory with little hope for the future. Amen

Wed 18th

Good shepherd, we thank you that the majority of children in Britain are protected from diseases and illness. We pray for the children in Pakistan that don't have access to vaccinations and the medicines which could save their life. Amen

Thurs 19th

Lord I thank you that here in UK both poor and rich children have access to free basic education. I pray for those who do not have access to life changing education due to their poverty. I thank you for the organisations like living hope who dedicate their efforts to reach out to the underprivileged offering them opportunities to learn. Amen

God, we praise you that we have so much choice in this country, choice over the food we eat, the clothes we wear and how we travel. We are thankful that we don't have to spend whole days travelling, or that we don't need to walk miles for simple things like water, but we remember those who do.

Mother God we bring you our prayers for all who are entrusted with the responsibility of motherhood. We pray for all the mothers figures in the world, recognising both the joy and responsibility they experience. The privilege and pressures, hopes and fears, pleasure and pain that motherhood entails. Thurs 2nd — Maundy Thursday


Take some time today to think of your feet and go for a walk if you are able. On Maundy Thursday the last supper is remembered, and at this Jesus washed his disciples' feet.
